## Past Grant Recipients

For almost 40 years, CSF has awarded nearly \$150,000 total in small grant amounts to over 350 groups and individuals. Recent recipients include **The Thurston Housing Land Trust, Window Seat Media, Multicultural Service Center of South Sound, Thurston County Inclusion, Restoring Earth Connection, and Nisqually Reach Nature Center.**

## Grant Applications

**Grants are disbursed in Fall & Spring**, and are based on the number of applicants, strength of applications, and available funding. Grant amounts usually range from \$100-600 (\$1,500 is the maximum that can be requested).
